The purpose and work of Woman's Missionary Union (WMU) is missions. Missions is not all that the church does. That is the Mission of the church. Missions with the "s" is what the church does to take the love of Jesus to people who are not a part of the Church and her programs. The target audience is people who are outside of the church, specifically those who do not know Jesus Christ.

Missions may be done in one's own community, in the association, in Georgia, across America, and around the world. The work of WMU includes:

- Mission action: ministering and witnessing to persons of special needs and/or circumstances. These needs may be physical, emotional, mental, and cultural.
- Witness: sharing the gospel message with a person and giving them the opportunity to respond; There is no special need or circumstance;
- Pray for missions: missionaries, missions needs, and personal involvement in missions;
- Support Missions: providing financial resources through the Cooperative Program and special offerings for State, North American, and International missions work; it includes ministering to missionaries and their families;
- Learn about missions: Areas covered are the biblical basis of missions; current missions; progress of Christian missions, and the spiritual development of the learner that leads to a missions lifestyle;
- Participating in the work of the church and denomination: Helping children, youth, and adults understand and accept the call to full-time missions service. It also is an informational responsibility of sharing missions information from the association, state, and Southern Baptist Convention.

WMU seeks to do this through church activities and age appropriate organizations. Missions is what the church does to take the love of Jesus to people outside the church and her programs.
